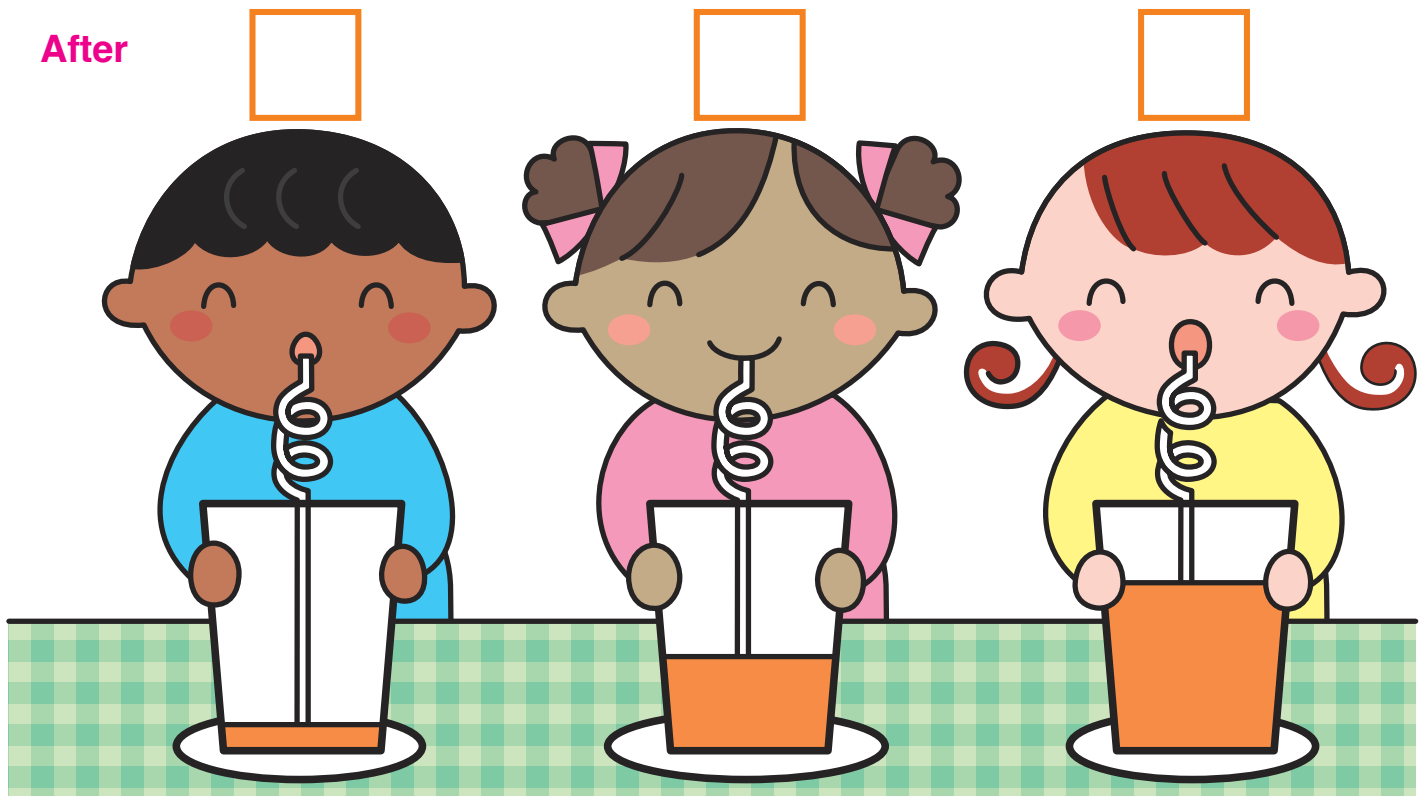
Let's Find Who Drank the Most
